

## **Thematic/charismatic cores for the celebration of the Franciscan Centenary 2023-2026**

The outline presented below is intended to focus on the charismatic cores with which we hope to characterise the years of the *Franciscan centenary* articulated and celebrated in the different centenaries.

For each year, the following are offered

- a title taken from the "Praises of God Most High" by St Francis;
- the particular centenary being celebrated;
- a unifying and characterising symbol;
- some summarised highlights of the contents that can be deepened according to four dimensions: theological, anthropological, ecclesiological and sociological. For further study, please refer to the *Guidelines* offered by the Conference of the Franciscan Family in its document of 1 January 2022.

This outline is offered to the general secretariats and other formation and organisational structures of the various institutes, entities and jurisdictions. We hope it can facilitate the development of formation programmes and activities to be implemented *ad intra* and *ad extra*, as a Franciscan Family, possibly in communion at the various levels.

It is a basic grid to be used with freedom and creativity, highlighting the unity of the project and integrating the various dimensions in continuity and process.

For each year, different sheets could be offered by the various sectors, possibly integrated with each other, accompanied by methodological suggestions for use.
